Admission Requirements:

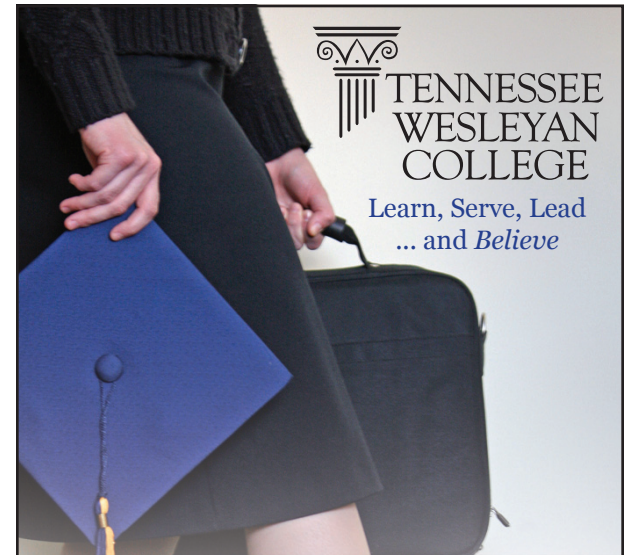
- Admission to Tennessee Wesleyan College
*Including a minimum GPA of 2.0 for
transfer students*
- Completion of at least 60 semester credit hours
from a post-secondary institution, as evidenced by
official transcripts sent directly from the college
or university to the Admissions Office
- At least 23 years of age and three years of
work experience
*Applicants under the age of 23 years or with less
than three years of work experience are
encouraged to apply and will be considered for
the program on an individual basis.*
- Submission of two letter of reference forms,
including one employer reference and
one character reference
- A writing sample of a 300-400 word essay
(approximately one page, double spaced, typed),
that includes the applicant's purpose and goals for
participating in the ME program
- A personal interview with the ME Director or a
ME Program Coordinator
- Payment of \$100 tuition deposit (applied to tuition)
to reserve space in the designated cohort group
(non-refundable and non-transferable)

Transfer students in pursuit of the BS in ME who
have earned an AA, AS, or 60 hours of transfer
credit from a regionally accredited institution are
considered to have met the General All College
Requirements (ACRs) at TWC with the exception of
the 30 hours of general education courses from the
ACR required by SACS including one course from
each of the following areas: humanities/fine arts,
social/behavioral sciences, and natural sciences/
mathematics plus the institutional requirement
of one religion course.
