NOTE: Final grades are due in the Registrar's Office no later than 48 hours after the exam. Grades for exams given on December 7th are due no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday, December 9, 2010. There will be no exceptions.

Final course examinations must comply with this schedule unless specific alternative arrangements have been approved in advance.

Students who have three regularly scheduled exams on one day may ask the assistance of their instructor in rescheduling the middle examination at a mutually convenient time. Arrangements must be made by the last day of class.
